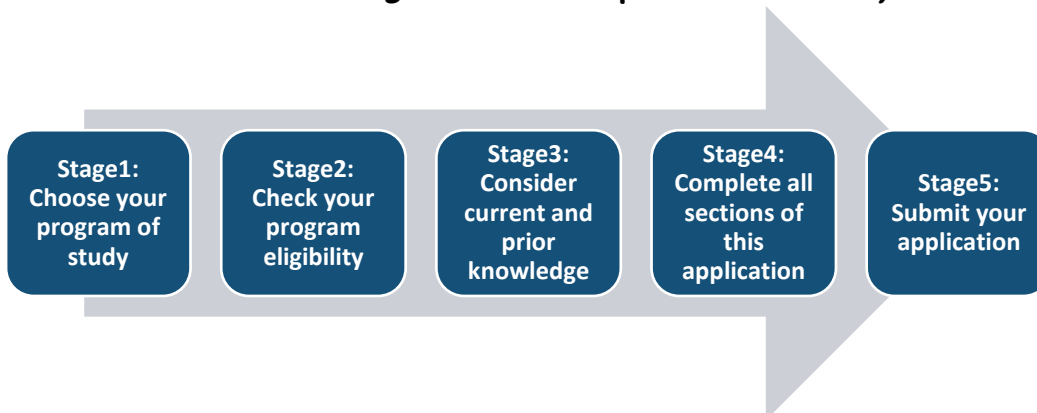

1. A certified copy of your Birth Certificate
2. A Passport Photo of yourself
3. Certified true copies of all certificates and relevant academic transcripts
4. Certified true copies of Tertiary Qualifications and transcripts from another institution or previous institution of TNU
5. A copy of your resume, including a record of any paid or volunteer work experiences
6. A reference letter from either your last employer/principal/head of school.
